Scottish Renewables Market

Scotland's energy industry is a force to be reckoned with. Scotland is home to more than 2 000 companies in the energy sector, operating in over 100 markets. This gives Scotland's highly developed energy industry truly global expertise.

Scotland's own abundant energy resources are being developed by a critical mass of companies and government targets commit Scotland to widespread adoption of renewable energy sources.

Scottish Renewable Energy Strengths

The Scottish Government's commitment to developing renewable energy markets includes some of the world's most ambitious targets.

These targets aim:

- To generate the equivalent of 100% of Scotland's own electricity demand from renewable resources by 2020
- To deliver an 80% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions by 2050, with an interim target of 42% reduction by 2020.

Scotland's natural energy strengths are impressive, including:

- 25% of Europe's wind resources
- 70 onshore wind farms with a current capacity of 1.8 GW
- Around 25 GW potential offshore wind capacity
- Around 7.5 GW potential tidal energy capacity
- Around 14 GW potential wave energy capacity
